(Look down at the ground. Can you count the dust? No, there are too many dust particles to count!)

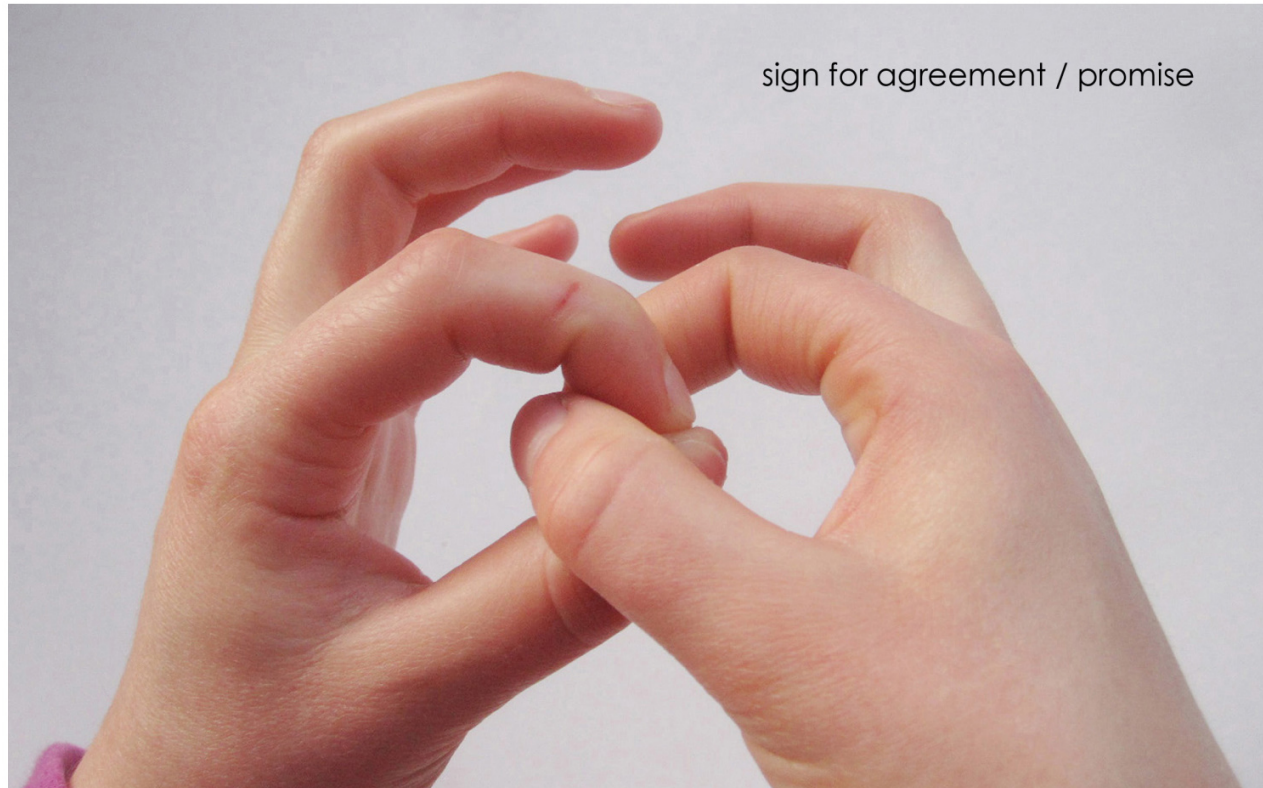


**Abram said, “Lord GOD, how can I give this land to my children if I don’t HAVE any children?” Sarai and Abram were getting old now!**

**God answered, “You will have a BABY, Abram. I promise. And your family will keep growing until it is so big you won’t be able to count them all!”**

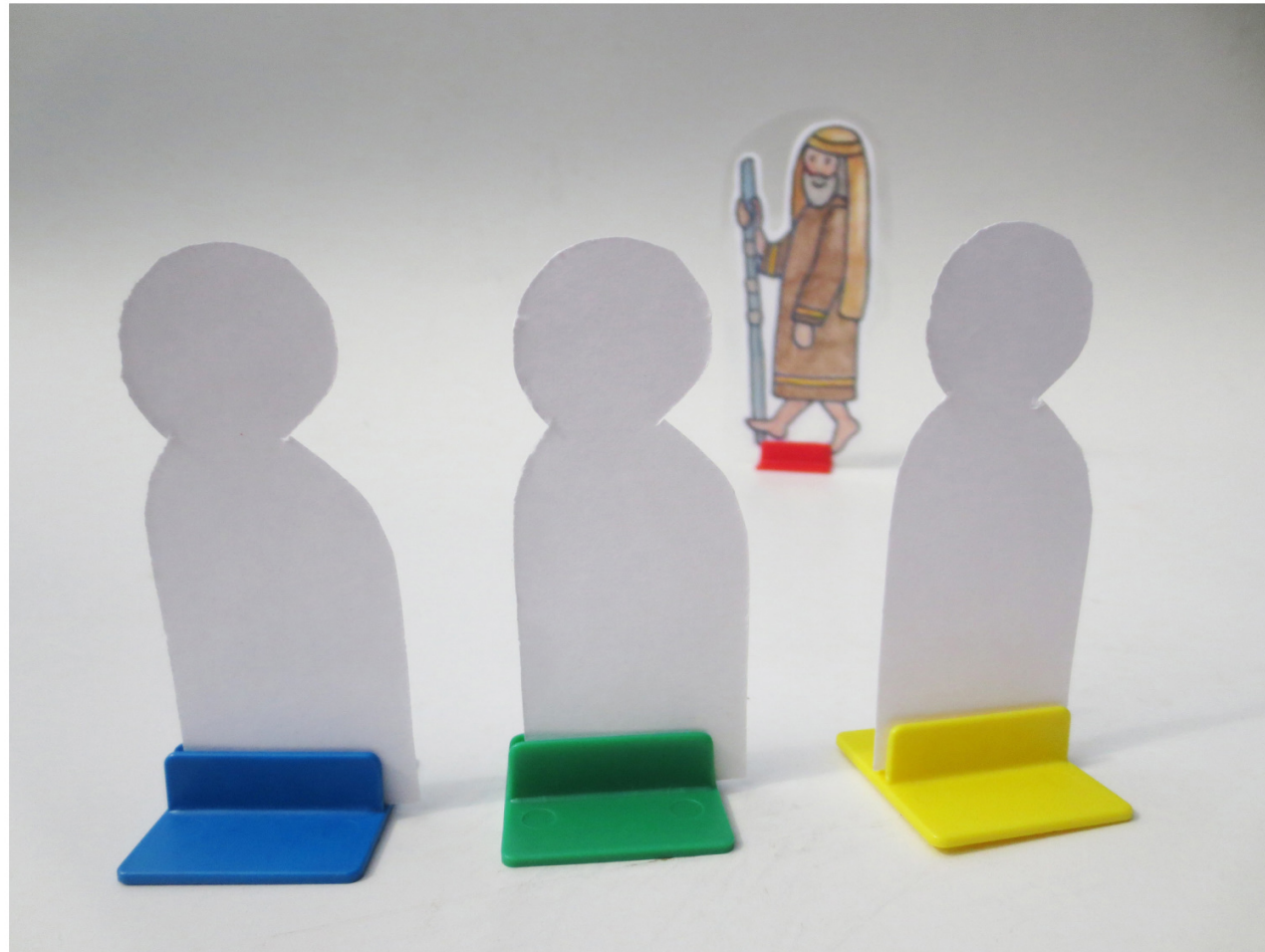
**(Look up at the night sky. Can you count the stars? No, there are too many stars to count!)**

**One day three men came to visit Abraham. They told Abraham that his wife Sarah would soon have the baby God promised him!**

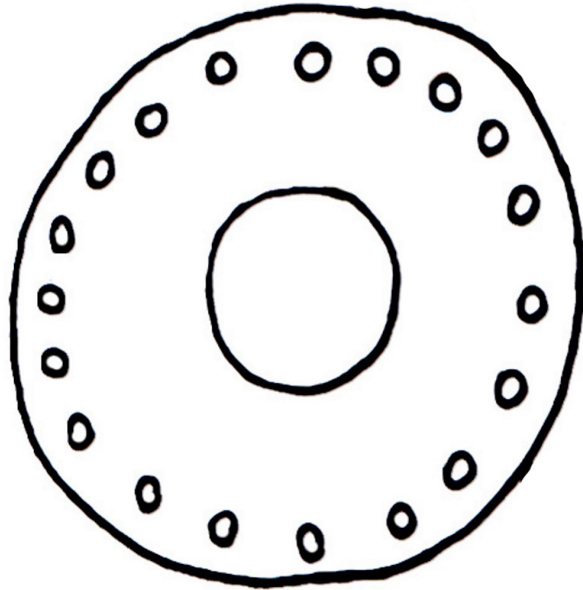


**Sarah was inside the tent. She heard them say, “Sarah will soon have the baby”. She laughed, “How can that happen? I am old now!”**
