



Noah and the Flood




When God finished His creation He saw that it was very good.




But the people God created turned away from Him. They listened to that sneaky, lying snake. As time went by, the world became filled with people who loved to do very bad things.






Noah was a good man. He loved God and did what was right. So God made a promise to Noah, "I will save you and your family, too."

So Noah listened and he obeyed. He did EXACTLY what God asked him to do.






father elephant = bull




The fountains were opened and it rained for 40 days and nights.


When the rains came down, the Ark floated




God made another promise to people everywhere....
