




Your Neighbor

Where was the man?


Oh no! What happened to the traveler?

He passed by on the other side and left the man to die.




Did man 1 say, "YES, I will help", or "NO, NOT ME"?

He passed by on the other side and left the man to die.




Did Man 2 say, "YES, I will help", or "NO, NOT ME"?


Along came man #3.

1. Washed his wounds




